The Delaware Disability Hub (DeIDHub) provides a rich assortment of valuable resources to support adolescents and young adults with disabilities in their transitions to becoming fully engaged citizens in their communities.

The move from adolescence to adulthood can be very challenging, especially for individuals with disabilities.
